PANEL II

Panel II addressed the new programme of work and institutional arrangements on Article 8(j) and other provisions of the Convention related to Indigenous Peoples and local communities. The panel focused on Indigenous Peoples and local communities' conservation, restoration, and sustainable use, and direct access to funding (Elements 1, 2, and 8).

Sara Amy Wyatt (GEF) was the moderator. Pablo Innecken Z. (FAO), Luis Guillermo Izquierdo Mora (President of the ICCA Consortitum), Terence Hay Edie UNDP/SGP), Anita Tzec, Senior Manager, International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), and Harold Ipuchima, National Focal Point for COP 16, MPC, were panelists.

Panel II was followed by a dialogue with the participants.

PANEL III

The third panel addressed the sharing of benefits from the utilization of genetic resources and digital sequence information on genetic resources, as well as traditional knowledge associated with genetic resources (Element 3).
