Background

- Voluntary Glossary of Key Terms and Concepts Within the Context of Article 8(j) and Related Provisions of the Convention on Biological Diversity was initiated under the programme of work on the implementation of Article 8(j) and related provisions of the Convention.
- In decision [14/13](#), the Conference of the Parties adopted the glossary developed by the Working Group at its tenth session and requested the Working Group to keep it in mind in its future work, as a living resource and reference, and to revisit and update it, when necessary, as might be appropriate as part of the post-2020 arrangements.

Mandate for the review and update of the glossary

- Decision [16/5](#), established the Subsidiary Body on Article 8(j) and Other Provisions of the Convention on Biological Diversity Related to Indigenous Peoples and Local Communities, which replaced the Working Group.
- Decision [16/4](#), adopted the programme of work on Article 8(j) and other provisions of the Convention related to indigenous peoples and local communities to 2030.
- Under Task 5.4 of the programme of work, the Subsidiary Body is requested to review and update, as needed, the glossary in the light of the adoption of the Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework.
